



## Things you might be wondering about . . .

**WHO** should attend the morning of reflection?

• **EVERYONE!** The morning of reflection invites all parishioners interested in social concerns, advocacy for the less fortunate, charity, Christian service and justice for everyone to attend, but especially **YOU**, our already dedicated leaders who show through your involvement your deep concern for people in need.

**WHAT** is my commitment?

- Besides the time it takes in your current ministry, we will hold meetings 6 times per year where we will come together as members of the Social Concerns Commission to share stories, discuss any needs of our ministries, pray and decide together what we will do to expand awareness of social concerns among our parishioners and encourage their participation.

**WHAT** happens to Faith in Action?

- The title “faith in action” will no longer be used but all of the ministries still exist and will now find a home under the Social Concerns Commission. This is the model recommended by the Diocesan Social Action Office for all parishes. Everything on the flow chart and everything we do as a parish puts our faith into action.
